



**REGULATIONS FOREIGN NON-ISU LISTED INTERNATIONAL INTERCLUB
COMPETITIONS
for
SINGLES & SYNCHRONIZED SKATING
SEASON 2017-2018**

Single skating

General rules for non-ISU listed International Interclub Competitions:

- All member skaters of Belgian clubs even **without** a Competition Level Figure Skating Test can compete in International Interclub Competitions except Belgian Competitions according the rules of this competitions.
- Skaters who are competing in the National Young Adult category **can** skate in foreign International Interclub Competitions in the categories of their level.
- Skaters **cannot** obtain a Figure Skating Level Test nor minimum required scores for the Belgian National Team (BNT) in International Interclub Competitions except in Belgian International Interclub Competitions.
- Before entering any skaters, the clubs must have forwarded foreign interclub announcements to the Sport Coordinator for approval.

- Skaters who can participate in B-Competitions cannot participate in foreign NON-ISU-listed interclub competitions when there is a B-Competition or an International interclub B-Competition on the same date as the NON-ISU listed interclub competition. This means no skater who can start in B-competitions, can participate in foreign NON-ISU listed interclub competitions in the period the Belgian competition takes place.
- Skaters who can participate in A-Competitions cannot participate in foreign NON-ISU-listed interclub competitions when there is a National A-Competition or an International interclub A-Competitions on the same date as the NON-ISU listed interclub competition. This means no skater who can start in A-competitions, can participate in foreign NON-ISU listed interclub competitions in the period the Belgian competition takes place.
- Belgian skaters who are member of a foreign club and who participate for this club in countries other than Belgium need to inform the national secretary and the Sport Coordinator by mail the latest three weeks before the competition starts. Judges score and results need to be sent to the national secretary and the Sport coordinator the latest five days after the conclusion of the event. However the result WON't count towards national level tests nor Belgian National Team results.

- When approved only the club of members can enter the skaters on International Interclub Competitions. The entries should be sent in copy to the Sport Coordinator and the General National Secretary.

Synchronized skating

General rules for non-ISU listed International Interclub Competitions:

- Before entering any teams, the clubs must have forwarded foreign interclub announcements to the Sport Coordinator for approval.

- When approved only the club of the synchro Teams can enter their Teams on International Interclub Competitions. The entries should be sent in copy to the Sport Coordinator and General secretary.

- **All participating Belgium Teams need to send in the complete results (including judges score) the latest five days after ending of the competition. If this is not the case, the scores won't count towards the scores for the Belgium National Team.**
- If a synchro Team reaches on a foreign non-ISU listed International Interclub Competition or in Belgium the requirements to compete in ISU-listed Competitions (Team B synchro), the Team can start immediately in this group. If there is a spot in a competition during the season the Team can be entered in this competition if they have the permission of the team manager/head coach.

Citizenship requirements:

Synchro Teams of Belgian skating clubs can compete in International ISU-listed Competitions and International Interclub Competitions if:

- They have the Belgian citizenship, (75% of a Team).
