FOREIGN NON ISU LISTED INT. INTERCLUB COMPETITIONS

SINGLES - SYNCHRONIZED SKATING - ICE DANCE SEASON 2022-2023

General rules for singles, ice dance & synchronized skating:

- For foreign International Interclub competitions we have two different groups:
 - Selected by KBKF/FRBPA Non ISU listed **& ISU listed International Interclub Competitions**
 - Non ISU listed International Interclub Competitions

1 - FOREIGN SELECTED NON LISTED & ISU LISTED INTERCLUB COMPETITIONS:

- All skaters who have the requirements to participate in **National A-competitions** can participate in:
 - Selected non-ISU listed International interclub competitions
 - Selected International interclub competitions linked to ISU listed competitions, if the announcements are separate from the ISU competition and not listed on the ISU website.
- In these selected interclub competitions, skaters can obtain minimum scores for BNT or Level tests. Skaters are **recommended** to participate abroad in the **same category** in interclub competitions as in Belgium.
In case a skater compete in a different category as in Belgium, scores **cannot** be taken into account for Level tests nor BNT minimum scores.
- Skaters can participate in selected Foreign International Interclub Competitions if these competitions do not coincide with Belgian A-competitions or International interclub A-competitions in Belgium.
- Ice dance teams and synchronized teams can obtain minimum required scores for the Belgian National Team (BNT) in selected International Interclub competitions.
Ice dance teams can participate in selected interclub competitions **the whole season**, because there are no national ice dance competitions. For Synchronized Teams is the National Championship obligated.
- The list of selected NON listed & International Interclub Competitions linked on an ISU listed competition but announced on ISU website will be published on :

Invitation and entering procedure:

- Invitations received by the clubs from foreign NON ISU listed interclub competitions and International interclub competitions linked to an ISU listed competition must first be sent to the National Secretary for approval before entering any skaters.
- Entries are made by the club of the skaters in selected non-ISU listed International Interclub Competitions & selected International interclub Competitions linked to an ISU listed competition are made by the club of the skaters, with the mail addresses below in copy..
- The club of the participating skaters must send in the complete results (including detailed judges' scores) of their participating skaters at the latest five (5) calendar days after ending the competition. If this is not the case, the scores won't count towards the scores for the BNT Team nor to obtaining a higher level. The entries and results must be sent by mail to the addresses below:

2 - FOREIGN NON ISU LISTED INTERNATIONAL INTERCLUB COMPETITIONS

- All member skaters of Belgian clubs even **without** a Competition Level Figure Skating Test nor PSC level may participate in not selected non-ISU listed International Interclub Competitions according the rules of these competitions.
- Single skaters who can participate in National B-Competitions **cannot** enter in **not selected** foreign non-ISU-listed Interclub Competitions when there is a National B- or a Belgian International Interclub B-competition **in the same week(end)** as the Foreign non-ISU listed Interclub Competition.
- Single skaters who can participate in National A-competitions cannot enter in **not selected** foreign NON-ISU-listed Interclub Competitions when there is a National A- or a Belgian International Interclub A-competition **in the same week(end)** as the foreign non-ISU listed Interclub Competition.
- Single skaters **cannot** obtain a Figure Skating Level Test, PCS Level Test nor minimum required scores for the Belgian National Team (BNT) in non-ISU listed International Interclub competitions.

Approval & entry requirements for not selected non-ISU listed Interclub Competitions:

- Invitations received by the clubs from foreign non ISU listed interclub competitions must first be sent to the National Secretariat for approval before entering any skaters.
