

1. TEAM DEFINITIONS

1. BNT Team Elite :

The current BNT Team A and criteria.

New criteria will be published in april 2019, after the European, World, and Junior World Championships.

2. (newly defined) BNT Team A :

- *Have reached at least the age of **twelve (12)** by July 1st preceding the competition for Ladies and Men.*
- *Have not reached the age of nineteen (19) by July 1st preceding the competition for Ladies and Men.*
- *Have obtained the minimum scores to qualify for National A-competitions and International Interclub A-competitions in Advanced Novice.*
- *Have obtained a minimum **Total Score of 90,00 points** (short + free) in Advanced Novice at National A-competitions, International Interclub A-competitions or ISU listed competitions. These scores need to be obtained in the second half of season 2018-2019 to qualify for season 2019-2020.*

3. BNT Team B :

Since TES and PCS minimum scores are already required on a national level, the criteria to qualify for BNT Team B are defined as a Total Score only :

- **BNO Girls :** **30,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **BNO Boys :** **29,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **INO Girls :** **33,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **INO Boys :** **32,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **ANO Girls :** **75,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **ANO Boys :** **84,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)
- **JUN Ladies :** **105,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points) (Short Program + Free Skating)
- **JUN Men :** **134,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points) (Short Program + Free Skating)
- **SEN Ladies :** **128,00 points** Total Score (Short Program + Free Skating)
- **SEN Men :** **166,00 points** Total Score (Short Program + Free Skating)

Starting from season 2019-2020, scores will be no longer be recalculated in order to participate in a lower category in a foreign competition.

Instead, skaters need to obtain specific minimum scores at National A-competitions, International Interclub A-competitions or ISU listed competitions in their own category to qualify for a lower category in ISU listed competitions, which is more transparant.

4. BNT Team C :

- *BNO Girls : **25,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *BNO Boys : **24,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *INO Girls : **29,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *INO Boys : **28,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *ANO Girls : **65,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *ANO Boys : **74,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points)*
- *JUN Ladies : **95,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points) (Short Program + Free Skating)*
- *JUN Men : **124,00 points** Total Score (without bonus points) (Short Program + Free Skating)*
- *SEN Ladies : **110,00 points** Total Score (Short Program + Free Skating)*
- *SEN Men : **150,00 points** Total Score (Short Program + Free Skating)*

2. GENERAL BNT REGULATIONS

1. Skaters who qualify for a national team in the first half of the season can only enter selected foreign international interclubs and ISU listed competitions in the second half of the season, due to already assigned entries and/or already passed closing dates.
2. All members of the national team are obliged to participate in the Belgian Championships. Only skaters who were invited to a Senior Grand Prix during that period are exempt from participation in the national championship. All other members of the national team can only renounce their participation after presenting a valid medical certificate of illness or injury.
