

To all who this may concern,

In view of the selection for the World Championships, the BNT regulations state that in case Belgium has more than one spot at the World Championship, and if there are two or more skaters who have reached the required National minimum Total Score and the minimum Technical Scores for ISU, an selection will be made by the board of the federation. This selection would be based on the average of the Total Segment Score of the Short Programs obtained during ISU Challenger Series of the season in which the Championships takes place.

In this paragraph, only the Challenger series were considered, based on the previous seasons where all relevant skaters participated in Challengers. However, due to the outstanding international results last season, this is not the case in the current season.

Since KBKF/FRBPA, the regional authorities and the Belgian Olympic Committee share the vision that at all times the best skaters should be sent to EC's, WC's en OWG, the selection made by KBKF/FRBPA will not only take into account Challenger Series, but also all ISU competitions of an equal or higher qualification. This way the criteria will also be in line with the criteria for JWC's.

Consequently, in view of the World Championships 2024, also the four Grand Prix will be taken into account, aswell as the European Championships 2024 which will have the most weight in the selection, except for a temporary injury.

The Belgian Championships will be a first gathering of, and measuring point for all senior skaters. We wish all of them the utmost succes at these nationals and the upcoming competitions.
