Participation: 1) **The organizer withholds the right to cancel categories or to limit the number of competitors**, if the number of registrations exceeds capacity especially in accordance with the Covid-19 regulations.

2) Registered athletes for assessment of approval for the national squad **NK2** of the DEU in the category **Advanced Novice and Junior** have priority and should inform the organizer at the time of registration.

Registration must be made exclusively by the Regional Association (**Landes-Eissport-Verband**). Here the report must be made via the respective club (incl. Registration list). The registration of the participants of German clubs must be made on the provided DEU form, (see Appendix). Before registration, validation of the data via the DEU Data Assistant at <http://deu-info.de/datenassistent/excel-validieren> must be completed.

Entry fee: **60,00 €** per competitor in Junior and Advanced Novice
40,00 € per competitor in Intermediate and Basic Novice, DEU AK U8
90,00 € per pair in Advanced Novice

If no judge is supplied by the national association (LEV) of the skater, the registration fee per competitor will be **120,00 € / 80,00 € / 180,00 €**

- Individual Results:** The marking system (ISU Judging System) will be used in accordance with the respective ISU Communications. The three best-placed skaters in each category will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. By registering for the competition, the skater agrees resp. the legal representative of the skater agree to the publishing of the results on the internet.
- Media/Internet:** Entry lists, results, photos, videos of athletes of the event will be published on the internet. With Competition Registration, the athlete or the athlete's legal representative agree to the publication of name, results, photos and videos.
- Live Stream/TV:** Live Stream of the Competition is provided. By entering the competition, each person agrees on recordings and/or transmissions (e.g. via the internet, TV) of his/her/their performance, appearance, picture, voice, or other personal characteristics displayed in connection with the event, towards an unrestricted audience and without temporal or geographical limits.
- Judges:** Participating clubs or associations are asked to supply one judge per team/ LEV with the minimum qualification "National championships". Hotel costs for judges must be paid by the registering club or association. The organizer withholds the right to choose the panel of judges.
- Music:** The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats by e-mail to hfp-music@tus-eissport.de **no later than 25. January 2023**. Any other format is not acceptable. Each submission must be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

1. GENERAL

The **Heiko Fischer Trophy 2023** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, as well as with the relevant ISU Communications.

In case of a very high number of skaters in one category, the organizer withholds the right to form several divisions in one category.

According ISU Rule 513 the starting orders for Junior and Advanced Novice Free Program will be in reverse order to the final result of the Short Programs. According to ISU Com. 2489 updated in all Novice categories warm-up groups will be up to 8 skaters.

The warm up time in all Novice categories will be according to ISU Com. 2489 updated

2. CATEGORIES SINGLES

DEU AK U8 Girls & Boys

The age requirements for **AK U8**: born after 1st of July 2014 and younger

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec for girls and boys

Free Skating only: A well - balanced Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 6 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. One jump combination or jump sequence can consist of up to three (3) jumps, the other up to two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of two or three jumps of any number of revolutions, in which the second and/or the third jump is an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first/second jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value. Only two (2) triple jumps can be repeated either in a jump combination or a jump sequence. Any single, double (incl. Double Axel) or triple jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation). One spin has to be a spin with no change of position. The other spin has to be a spin in a different basic position or a spin combination. A spin without change foot minimum six (6) revolutions, a spin with change of foot minimum eight (8) revolutions. Change of foot are in both spins optional, **in both spins flying entry is not allowed.**
- c) There must be one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

3. CATEGORY PAIR SKATING

This category will only take place if there is a sufficient number of participants.

Duration: 2:20 min, +/- 10 sec
