Team Future, Junior – Junior Grand Prix selection

---

**Junior Future Team**

- a) **Age requirements** : Skaters who have turned 13 years of age before July 1, 2026, and have not yet turned 19 (singles) or 21 (ice dancers).
- b) **Qualification requirements** : Skaters/couples must have obtained the required National Total Result Score for JGP's **OR** the ISU Combined Element Score for JWC at the discipline in which they participate.  
These scores can be obtained at ISU-listed Competitions and Belgian National Championships in the Junior category during the ongoing season 2026-2027 or the preceding season 2025-2026.
- c) **JGP entries** : are made by the federation using the ORS system.

**National Total Result Scores for Junior Grand Prix series 2026-2027 :**

In view of the selection of the skaters/couples going to the JGP's the federation considers two categories :

- Skaters/couples who obtained the National Total Result Score for JGP's according to their age (Hard Criterion) ;
- Skaters/couples who did not obtain their Hard Criterion, but obtained at least the minimum score for the lowest age (Soft Criterion).

**Composition of the Junior Grand Prix Hard and Soft Criteria**

The criteria are obtained by calculating the average Total Result Scores of the place/ranking, mentioned in the table, obtained during every Junior Grand Prix of the preceding season, the Grand Prix Finals not included :

**Step 1** : Depending on how many JGP's Belgium gets assigned from the ISU, first the skaters/couples who obtained their Hard Criterion will get one JGP each (if possible). If a skater/couple has the possibility to qualify for the Grand Prix Finals, the skater/couple will get two JGP's.

**Step 2** : Any remaining JGP's and substitute assignments will further be assigned to the skaters who obtained their Hard Criterion.

**Step 3** : Any remaining JGP's and substitute assignments after Step 2 will further be assigned to the skaters/couples who only obtained the Soft Criterion.

If the number of qualified skaters/couples is higher than the number of assigned JGP's, the Federation takes the final decision, taking into consideration the age(s) of the skater(s), the highest Total Result Score obtained during the qualifying competitions, and to what extent that score relates to the required criteria.
